We will be taking a whole class photo for the front covers of the children's end of year reports. If you have any objections to your child being in this photograph, please let the school office know.



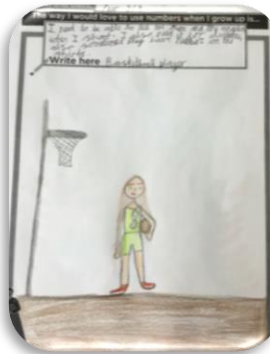

We love maths: Children in Y3/4 have been thinking about how maths will be important in their future careers choices.

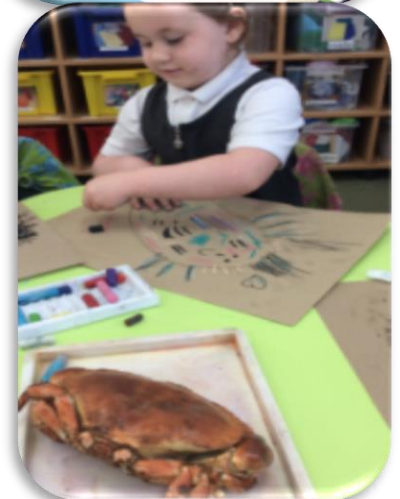


We love maths: Finding out about famous mathematicians; looking at maths in the environment and finishing with a party planning budget activity in Y5/6
