Rugby stars

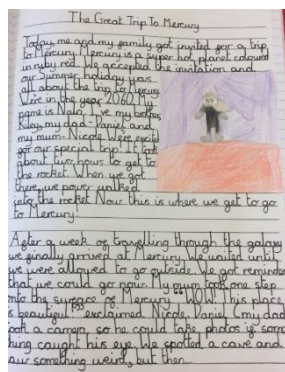
