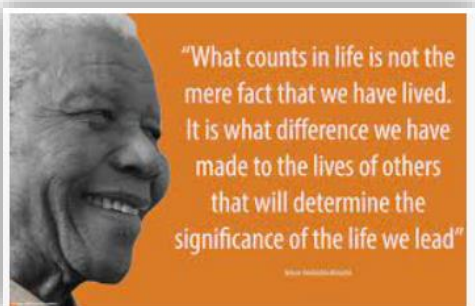




# St Swithun's News
