PE KITS: Please make sure that your child has their PE kit in school every day of the week.

PE uniform: black shorts, white T-shirts and black pumps/trainers.

Please do not send your child to school with club football shirts or coloured leggings. It is important that children are dressed appropriately and feel part of a team. They can bring PE kits to school on a Monday and take them home on a Friday.

Ear piercings:

If you are considering having your child's ears pierced, the best time to do this is during the school summer holidays please. Children are not allowed to wear earrings for swimming, and they will need to take studs out for PE lessons for health and safety reasons.

Y6 swimming

We believe that it is essential that every child should leave St Swithun's being able to swim 25metres.

So that all children can have more intensive swimming training (3 coaches to 19 children) we have decided to take Y6 children on their own rather than mixing the year groups.
