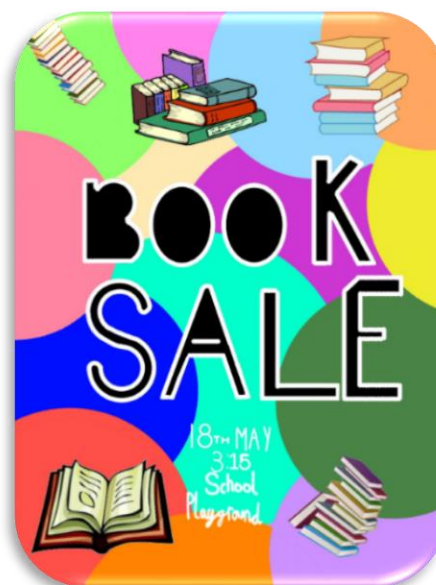
Our new Librarians Pre-loved Book Sale
