Breakfast Club:

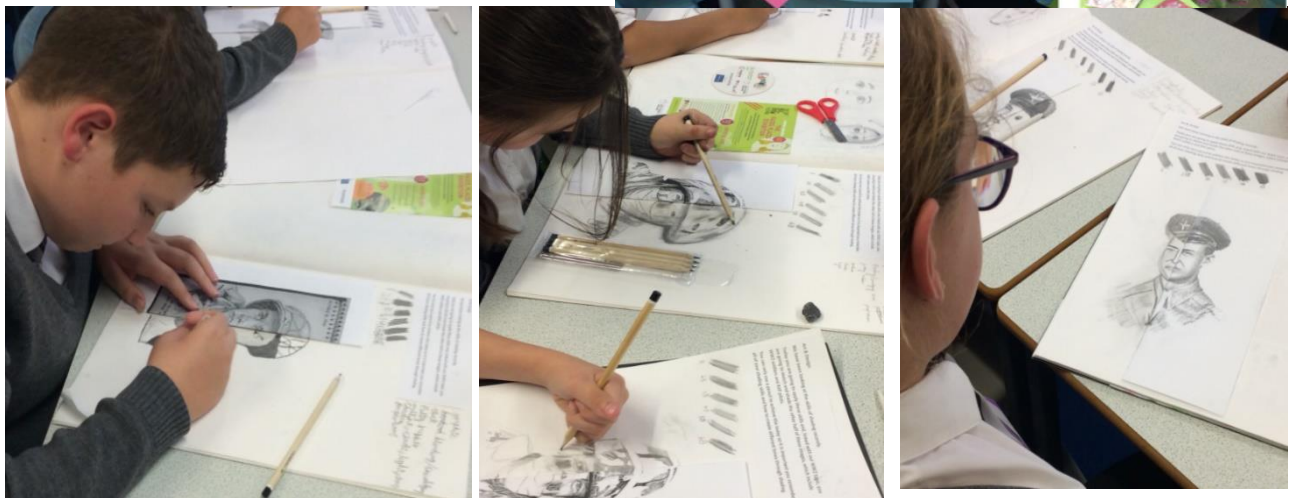
