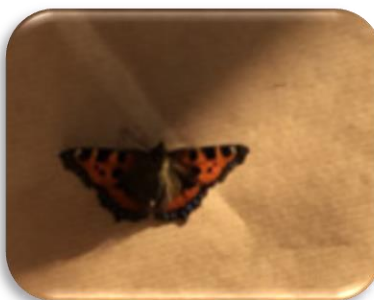


Clumber Class:
