

## St-Swithun's Times Tables Whole School Overview 2023-2024

- Whole school Times Table progression table, indicates an order in which times tables are taught and practised.
- Children taught once explicit lesson on a set of times table per half term.
- Children focus mainly on the half termly times table alongside continuing retrieval practise of other known times tables through daily counting, fluency and TTRS practise.
- Weekly times table test on the half term focus time tables, how this is done, is down to individual classes.
